Martin D. Levin, DMD

Dr. Levin is in private practice limited to endodontics in Chevy Chase, Maryland and is Adjunct Associate Professor, Department of Endodontics, Nova Southeastern University, College of Dental Medicine. At the University of Maryland, College of Dental Medicine, he is a Clinical Associate Professor in the Department of Endodontics, Prosthodontics and Operative Dentistry. At the University of Pennsylvania, School of Dental Medicine, Dr. Levin received the Alumni Award of Merit and served as Chair of the Board of Overseers from 2004-2008 and remains a member of the board. He is recognized as a Distinguished Practitioner in the National Academies of Practice in Dentistry.

He is a contributor to the 8th, 9th and 10th Editions of "Pathways of the Pulp" and the 6th Edition of "Ingle's Endodontics," as well as the author of numerous peer-reviewed articles. He is a recognized expert who speaks, both nationally and internationally on advanced technologies in endodontic practice and office operations management.

Dr. Levin graduated with honors from Emory University in 1968, and earned his degree in dental medicine from the University of Pennsylvania in 1972, where he was a member of the Omicron Kappa Upsilon Honor Society. After completing his post-doctoral residency in endodontics at the University of Pennsylvania, he became a Diplomate of the American Board of Endodontics, and a member of the College of Diplomates.
